ABSTRACT:



1. INTRODUCTION

A library is the backbone of any educational institution. Libraries function as an essential integral component in higher education system. Today, college libraries are functioning as a hub of knowledge in disseminating knowledge. The library environment is currently undergoing a rapid and dynamic change which is attracting its users to use the library to its maximum. To meet the end-users demands effectively, the college libraries need to identify and adopt good practices to motive its users and satisfy their information needs.

Effective library management skills (eg. Open access). instructional programme (eg. User awareness program) are necessary to motivate the library users of a college which comprises students. teachers, research scholars, staffs and solve their information needs. Meeting their demands not only stimulate their intellectual curiosity but also encourages them to continue seek information and exploration. Effective library and information shills and instructional programs help the students to acquire the skills they need to solve their information needs.






Fig1. Location map of the study area in Sivasagar District of Assam.

Library services in higher education plays a central role in enhancing the quality of academic and research environment. Best practices are applied in an insovative way for a positive impact. A college librarian is responsible for attracting its users to use the library effectively and sensibly. S/he uses or applies best skills to motivate the users and gives best services to its users to satisfy their information needs. In this paper, we have made an attempt to discuss some vital issues which are needed to be developed by the college librarians for more effective ways to motivate its users and satisfy their information needs.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY

The main objectives of the study are as follows:-

- To know the best practices applied by the college libraries of Sivasagar district.
- To know the best methods to motivate the users to use the college library.

3. METHODOLOGY

The study is mainly based on the primary data collected from

the librarians in the selected college libraries of Sivasaga district, Assam A structured questionnaire was formed based on the objectives of study A structured quantitative of Structures of Siversagar district. The data obtained by these colleges have been tabulated, interpreted and analyzed in the light of objectives of the study and result have been depicted in the succeeding section.

4. SURVEYED COLLEGE LIBRARIES OF SIVASAGAR L'ISTRICT:

A College library is defined as *a library established, reaintained and administered by a college to meet the needs of its students and faculty* (Ray, Prytherch; 1990). The basic common effort of all college libraries should be to meet the legitimate needs and demands of all the college communities. The basic function of the college library should be to assist both curricular and extra-curricular activities of college education and for shouldering the higher responsibilities in future life.

The govt of Assam through an act The Assam College Employees (Provincialisation) Act, 2005 provincialised the general degree colleges in Assam. Our present study includes only the selected government provincialised colleges of Sivasagar district. Out of all the government provincialised degree colleges of Sivasagar District we have selected thirteen (33) colleges and their libraries for our study.

5. BEST PRACTICES TO MOTIVATE USERS:

5.1 Administration and Management

Maintenance of the Service areas:

Library is a place where many people visit to read, consult and borrow reading materials. It is necessary the atmosphere in the Library is inviting with cleanliness of areas in and outside of the library. Maintenance of calm and neat atmosphere in the reading and stack areas is a must for concentrated reading and searching of materials.

5,2 Collection and Services:

Collection Development:

A college Library should contain the quantity of resources as

prescribed by the government, UGC and other governing bodies. They may generally be in the form of books, text books. standard reference, current journals which include national. international and peer reviewed journals, back volumes, eresources such as full text/secondary databases, CDs/DVDs. AV materials, etc.

Library Book Exhibition:

College library can organize book exhibition inviting some leading publishers throughout the country. Students and faculty members may select books on apot and it will help to motivate the users in the college libraries.

5.3 Extent of the use of services

- Liser Education:
- To raise awareness about library services.
- To optimum utilization of the library
- To provide guidance on accessing the library resources.

User Orientation Programme:

Library has been conduct orientation programme to the new students admitted every academic session. Students attend the programme according to the time table drawn by the library. Students are explained about the resources, facilities, services, the library provides them. They are taken round in the library apart from the training them in searching library databases, ejournals, OPAC search etc. Students find it useful to know about the resources available in their discipline. This programme will certainly motivate the user community of the college libraries.

Library Best Reader Award:

The objective of the best reader award is to attract more students to visit the library and also increase the use of resources in the library. Data is collected through the visitors register maintained in the college library. Usage data is compiled

through circulation of library items. Based on the above data and observation of the librarian this award is given to the students who has made maximum use of the library. At last award is given to the winner at the time of the annual programme of the college. Cash/Book in the form of award can be given to the best user from each discipline.

User feedback Practice through suggestion Box:
This is the way to know the users need and motivate the users in the college libraries. User's feedback is collected on all aspects of the library services formally through suggestion box. Appropriate actions are initiated regular basis on the suggestion received, flook recommendation boxes are also kept in different places in the library to encourage the readers. It will helps in the collection development, changes and improvement in facilities and services of the college libraries.

5.4 Application of IT in the library Services:

- Opening free Browning Unit (Internet Access Facility): College library should open free browning unit to provide access to the web resources, to educate users.
- Library Home Page for dissemination of information:
 College library should create library homepage for dissemination of current information, it should be updated regularly for the attraction of the user community. All the latest happenings of the library are to be uploaded in this page.
- Automated circulation systems
 College library should create the environment of automated circulation system. Smart card technology, bar-coded identity card should be introduced in the library for the benefit of the user as well as the stall.
- Web OPAC:
 Littery collection availability and its status are very important for the users. The card catalogue is converted in to machine.

7. DISCUSSION:

1. The collection development policy is limited in all the college libraries of Sivasagar district. All the surveyed college libraries collect only printed books, journals, magazines and daily her Practices in Academic Libraries: Somes and Challenges

- newspaper, 5ome of the Colleges have E-book, a-journal, edatabases in their libraries.
- 2. (46.15%) of the college libraries provide the services of N-list programme of Infilhert. Only one (7.69%) surveyed college library provide UGC Infonet service.
- 3. Open access system is followed in 10 (76,92%) of the college libraries of sivauagar district. Only three numbers (23.07%) of colleges follow closed access system.
- 4. 12 mambers (92.3%) of college libraries implemented SOUL softs are for automation of library activities.
- 5. Broadband internet service is connected in 12 (92.3%) college libraries. One (7.69%) college library presently using data card for Internet connectivity.
- 6. Reference Service, Information Service and photocopying service is provided in all the surveyed college libraries of strusagar dustrict in Assam.
- 7. (16.66%) college libraries using Bercode technology for circulation management for saving the time of the user. Other college libraries yet to be implemented this technology. They still follow the manual system for issue/return of library documents.
- 8. All (100%) surveyed college libraries conduct User orientation programme for library awareness of the user.
- 9. Library video show is effective to the user to know the different sections and their activities, it is yet to be implemented in the college libraries of sivasagar district. One few colleges provided library orientation classes through LCD Projector (dide show)
- 10. Library website is not available in all the colleges of Sivasagar
- 11. Best reader award is offered in 10(76.92%) surveyed college libraries. Only 3 colleges are yet to be offered this award to motivate the
- 12. Book fair is conducted to aware the reader about new arrival in their discipline. Nine (69.23%) of the surveyed college libraries conduct book fair in the college premises.

- 23. Reading room environment is found good in most of the college libraries provide the college Reading room facility.

 (15.38%) of the surveyed college libraries provide to conditioned reading room facility.
- constitioned reading college libraries provide OPAC facility to the last 14. Seven (53.64%) college libraries yet to be implemented as Seven (53.54%) Other use (53.54%) Other 46.15% college libraries yet to be implemented the OPAC facility to the user.

& SUGGESSIONS AND CONCLUSION:

The following suggestions were drawn for the college libraries to motivation and satisfy the information needs of the users.

- > College libraries should be enriched with the latest collection of books, journals and magazines in different formats. Students and the faculty members to be encouraged to select their required documents by organizing book exhibition cum spot book selector programme in the college premises. The college librarian about take proper initiative for organizing the same to motivate the user.
- Orientation Programme should be organized in frequent way to encourage not only the students but also the faculty members of the college. Internet training, Awareness programme on latest development (such as e-resources, searching technique, and OPAC use, N-List) should be organized in the libraries to satisfy their information needs of the user.
- Best reader award should be offered in all the surveyed college libraries in each discipline. They may be awarded in the annual programme of the college, so that others are motivated to visit the library,
- Library interior design should be attractive to motivate the users. The library furniture and the sitting arrangement should be standard one to encourage for reading inside the library. The College librarian should maintain a reading atmosphere in the library.
- > Open access system should be introduced, not only for the Textbook and General books but also for the Reference collection of the
- There should be Broadband connectivity for the internet connection Local Area Network provision is essential in the college libraries

 All the nurveyed college libraries abould regulared their sums for UGC Infimut and N-List Services for the user community. Users should be trained up about these two services and their utility.

No academic institution can survive without a library, which is inclispernable for the achievement of the victors and mission of its parvet body. To survive in the rapidly changed technology sollege libration should constantly gauge and examine user's needs. Professionals need to change their mindset with the changes of the beclinology.
